- Write about your sculpture using your notes. Add a photo of your sculpture. Look at the **example**:

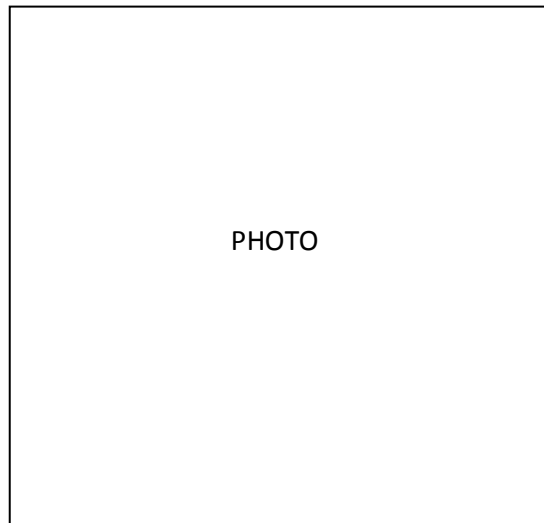
EXPRESS THE ARTIST IN YOU!
