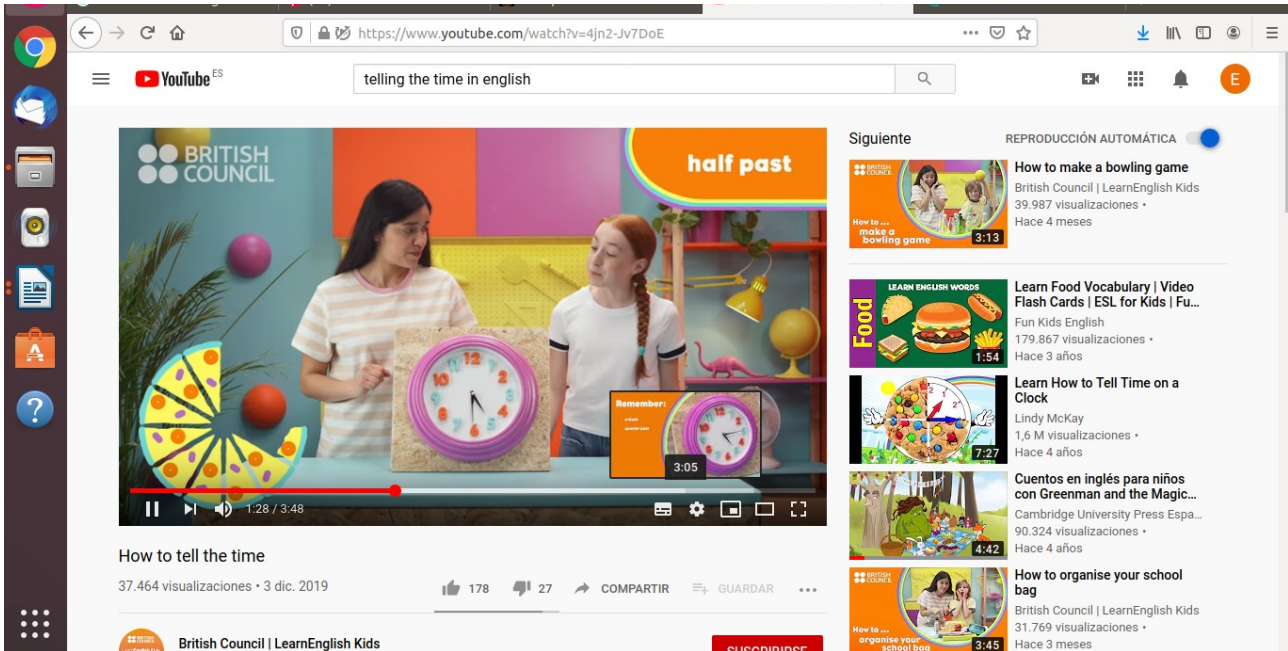
This is our sixth home schooling week. Are you ready for a new challenge? Hope you all are doing well.

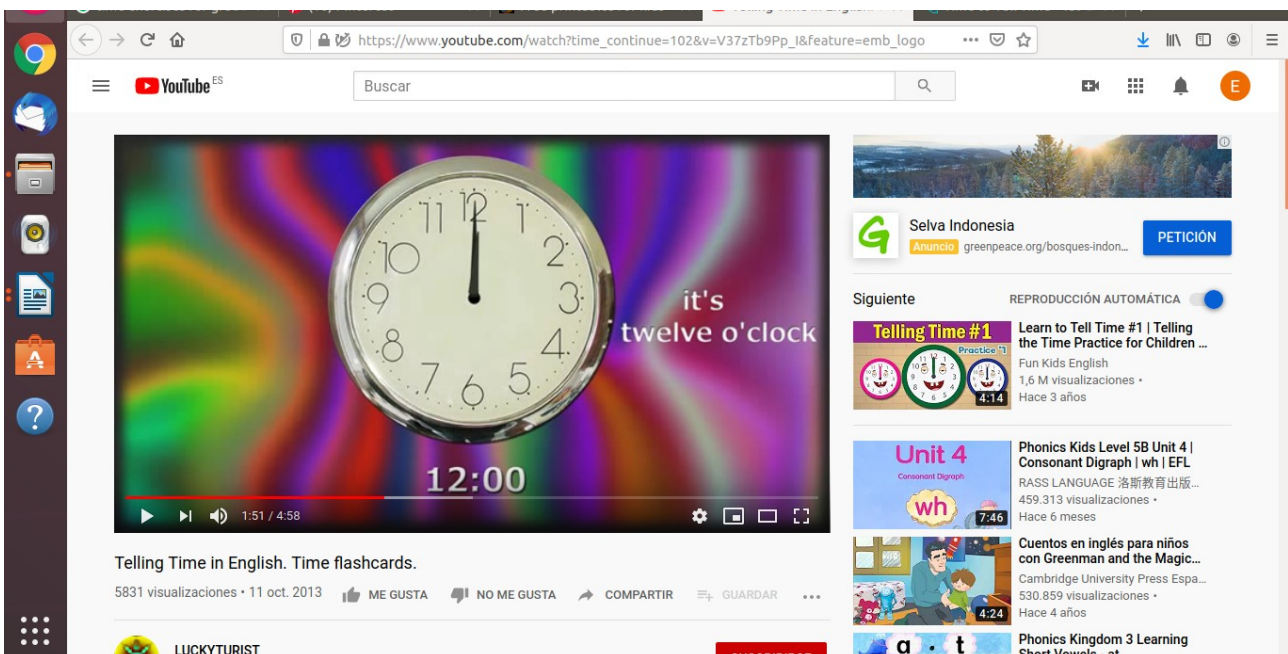
